LCBP: will ask for funds to plant trees, to map Japanese knotweed, for Org Support to collaborate, and for "thank you" project that highlights the work we've done with landowners – postcard mailing. Discussions: funds for storm drains – possibly paint them bright to attract attention, instead of the usual words? What about funds to cover the potential raised cost of switching from contractor to employee?

Annual Appeal: in addition to annual report/membership drive? Water-sampling specific ask? Rather than mailing list wide ask, maybe a nudge reminder to previous donors?

2019 calendar for sale at 14th Star event – we will ask \$15 this year.

Applying for funds from CVNHP for signage/work on the fishing platform on the North Troy property.

6) Projects Update

Lindsey had an inquiry about if there were any wetland restoration projects in the MRBA past? Dale Cahill – planting or brushrolls?

In the interest of leaving plenty of time to discuss the 14th Star event, we will shelve discussion of the other projects until a later meeting.
